1- Hire a Home Inspector with lots of experience:

Part-time inspectors simply do not have the proper time in the field to develop that kind of radar. Be sure to ask how many inspections he/she performs annually and for how many years. A good home inspector does at least 200 to 300 inspections annually, Blind inspectors conduct 50 to 100 inspections annually. Conducting 200 to 300 inspections each year requires extensive referrals by prior clients, lenders, real estate agents and others. So there is a much greater chance that the inspector isn't blind.
